Whether your child is in need of back to school vaccinations, a sports physical, or just an annual checkup, the start of a new school year can be a great reminder to schedule an appointment with a pediatrician or primary care physician.

"Annual exams allow a physician to track a child's progress and development over time, as well as develop a medical history," says Charles Whitehead, M.D., a family medicine physician with Memorial Hermann Medical Group Memorial City. "Should your child be involved in a sport, most schools require a sports physical where a physician can also address issues like nutrition and injury prevention."
