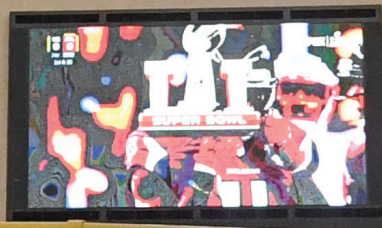

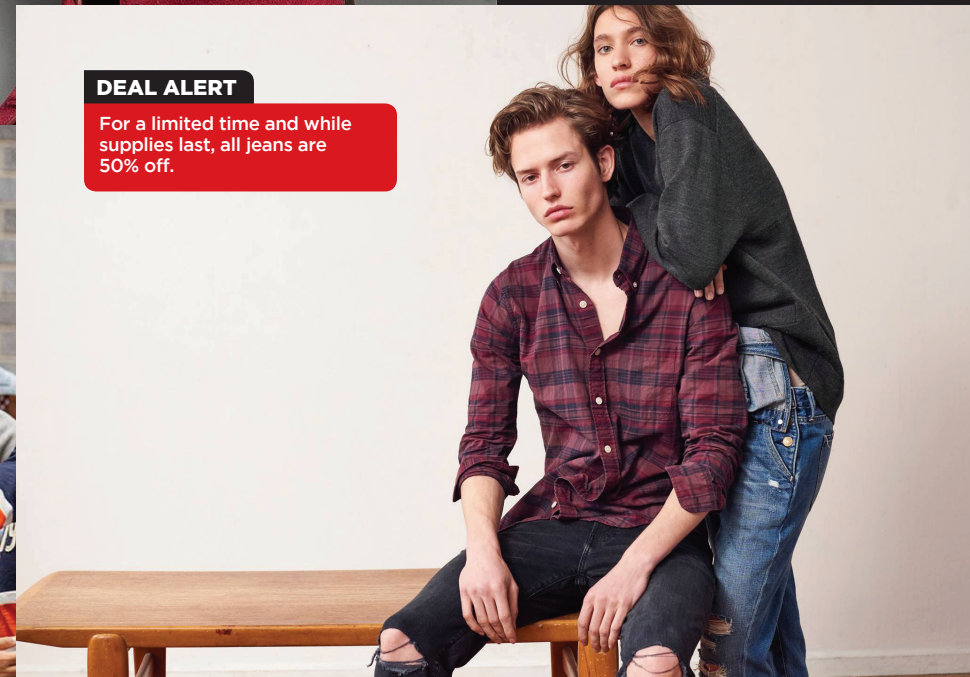

## Men - Get Your Screening!

The American Cancer Society reports one in seven men will be diagnosed with prostate cancer in his lifetime, making it the second most common cancer diagnosed in men. That's why Memorial Hermann Medical Group physicians urge men to consider annual prostate cancer screenings beginning between the ages of 40 and 50 years old.

*"A man's family history, age, and ethnicity play big roles in his individual prostate risk," says M'Liss Hudson, M.D., a urologic oncologist with Memorial Hermann Medical Group Urology Memorial City. "Have a conversation with a physician about your risk factors, and make an informed decision on whether prostate cancer screening is right for you."*
